## Friends of Steinert High School Jazz, Inc. Meeting Minutes - March 22, 2010

- I. Meeting was called to order by Steve K. at 8:31 PM
- II. Secretary's Report was presented by Charlie G.
  - ◆ The meeting minutes from the February 22, 2010 meeting were deposited on the website
  - ◆ Motion was made by Rose P. to not read the minutes. This was seconded by John G. and approved.
- III. Treasurer's Report was presented by Mike K.
  - ◆ Ending Balance as of 2/28/10 was \$12,371.32
  - ◆ A motion was made by John B. to approve the financial report; this was seconded by Marty T. and approved.
- IV. Vice President's reports
  - A. Marty T.
    - ◆ Advertisement sales for the Jazz Festival's advertisement book exceeded last year by ~\$1000 with a final total of \$6530. Twelve of 43 students were eligible for an incentive award and Alexis K. was our top seller. Letters and two free admissions to the event were sent to companies or people who purchased half or full page advertisements. Steve K. And Marty T. thanked all for participating and will thank students immediately after the Jazz Festival.

    - ◆ Picnic is tentatively scheduled for June 12 at the Italian American Club. FoSJ will provide meats and rolls. Families will provide other foods and John B. will coordinate efforts. Although sunshine was ordered, rain date is Sunday, June 13.
- V. The President's report and Old Business was presented by Steve K.
  - ◆ Steve K. thanked everyone for their help at the preliminary jazz competition. He indicated that a similar number of bands are expected at our Jazz Festival with additional families from other bands expected to attend.
  - ◆ The storage facility is now being used and is larger than originally planned. Steve K. thanked Mike and Marianna K. for storing the electronic equipment over the last year.
  - ◆ The DaVinci's pizza fundraiser is ongoing until April 1. The Red Robin fundraiser provided \$280 back to FoSJ and the total profit from Chevy's fundraiser was not yet known.

VI. The Director's Report was presented by Mr. Mike A.

- ◆ Preliminary Jazz Competition ran smoothly and he received favorable comments from other directors. He thanked everyone for their help. The Jazz Band will perform in the State Finals at Princeton High School on Saturday, April 24. FoSJ was asked to help with transporting equipment.
- ◆ The trip to Boston was a success with the band performing well and placing 10<sup>th</sup> among 16 bands. Mr. A. complimented the behavior of the students.
- ◆ Both bands will perform at Willingboro on April 15 and buses have been ordered.
- ◆ Mr. A. reviewed details for the Jazz Festival. Students were asked to report at 1:00 PM to help set up and then again at 4:15 PM. An additional band has been added to the program, Ewing High School, and will perform after Reynold's Middle School. The festival will feature two clinicians to provide feedback to all of the bands. In addition, two judges will work with a modified rating system in which all bands will be given a participation trophy, an Outstanding Musician will be awarded for each band and overall Outstanding Sections (4) and Outstanding Musicians (4) will be awarded. Melissa G. offered to donate the frames required for the awards.
- ◆ The Jazz Band will visit the Mercer County School for Special Services on April 1.
- ◆ Both bands will participate in the Band Concert on May 26 and the Pops Concert on June 2, depending on Mr. Dave P.'s availability.
